



Dear Student,

Mastering a foreign language requires a lot of courage and perseverance and I already admire you for making the decision to give it a try! I really want to help you so that you will be able to do things with less effort and more efficiently. I hope the following pieces of advice will be of some help to your endeavour in English.

1. Read out loud (at least 5 minutes a day) parts from the coursebook that you've already been taught.
2. Use highlighters for everything! While studying underline using different colours for headings, expressions, individual words that you find difficult, grammar rules you can't remember, etc. When you revise don't start from scratch but focus on the things you have highlighted.
3. Use real space, your room for example, to display information that you need or to recite expressions. This way you will associate them with a familiar location and it will be easier for your memory to retrieve information when needed.
4. When you aren't sure check online the pronunciation of any word that troubles you. Always do that!
5. Make your own notes-maps when you study Grammar. Pretend you are a teacher and you need to keep notes of crucial points so that they can remind you of the details.
6. Connect daily watching TV episodes with certain activities (having a snack, drinking coffee, smoking, etc) so that you never forget to do them.
7. Scream, tear pieces of paper, break pencils, burst out crying if necessary when you feel the pressure is too much and you need to let out some steam. We all have been there!
8. Always keep in mind that you are stronger than any piece of Vocabulary or Grammar and that you will eventually conquer it with the right technique and the passage of time.
9. If you wake up with a word stuck in your head and you don't remember its meaning this shows that you have reached a desirable level of studying.
10. Always try to learn words in sentences and in a certain context, never on their own.

Study and revise constantly but in multiple ways. Adopt a system that will help your memory to retain and easily retrieve information.
