





## **Vocabulary activity:**

Frankenstein is a famousnovel written by Mary Shelley in 1818. It tells the story of
Victor Frankenstein, a young scientist who creates a livingbeing from parts of dead
bodies. Victor brings the creature tolife, but when he sees how it looks, he is horrified
and abandons it. The creature, who has noname, feels lonely and sad because people
are afraid of him and treat him badly. This makes the creature angry, leading to many
tragic events. The novel explores themes such as ambition, responsibility, and
loneliness It also asks important questions about the dangers of science and how
humans should treat those who are _different Shelley wrote <i>Frankenstein</i> when she
was just 18 years old, inspired by the scientific ideas of hertime



### The film

Mary Shelley's Frankenstein is a 1994 science fiction horror film directed by Kenneth Branagh who also stars as Victor Frankenstein, with Robert De Niro portraying Frankenstein's monster (called The Creation in the film), and co-stars Tom Hulce, Helena Bonham Carter, Ian Holm, John Cleese, Richard Briers and Aidan Quinn. Considered the most faithful film adaptation of Mary Shelley's 1818 novel, Frankenstein; or, The Modern Prometheus, despite several differences and additions in plot from the novel, the film follows a medical student named Victor Frankenstein who creates new life in the form of a monster composed of various corpses' body parts. ### The book

<u>Frankenstein:</u> or, The Modern Prometheus is an 1818 novel written by English author <u>Mary Shelley</u>. Frankenstein tells the story of <u>Victor Frankenstein</u>, a young scientist who creates a <u>sapient creature</u> in an unorthodox scientific experiment. Shelley started writing the story when she was 18, and the first edition was published anonymously in London on 1 January 1818, when she was 20. Her name first appeared in the second edition, which was published in Paris in 1821. (information from Wikipedia)

#### The author

Mary Wollstonecraft Shelley (1797 – 1851) was an English novelist who wrote the Gothic novel Frankenstein; or, The Modern Prometheus (1818), which is considered an early example of science fiction. She also edited and promoted the works of her husband, the Romantic poet and philosopher Percy Bysshe Shelley. Her father was the political philosopher William Godwin and her mother was the philosopher and women's rights advocate Mary Wollstonecraft. (information from Wikipedia)
