Answers to the questions:

- 1 The choice was between giving a false confession or risking a public hanging.
- 2 In the village of Salem Massachusetts between February 1692-May 1693
- 3 The Puritans believed that the Devil wreaked havoc through human agents known as witches.
- 4 There were 12 girls
- 5 Sarah Osbourne died in prison, while Sarah Good was convicted and hanged shortly after her baby died.
- 6 They were not really interested in thoroughly investigating the charges, instead they preferred that the accused confessed and asked for forgiveness.
- 7 The court accepted all kinds of dubious evidence, including "spectral evidence" where the girls raved when touched by invisible ghosts.
- 8 They came under suspicion
- 9 Twenty people were executed (14 women and 6 men)
- 10 The governor suspended the trials when his own wife was accused, leading to the release of prisoners and the end of arrests.
- 11 Students answers may vary. Some may mention the fact that adults accepted wild accusations by children as hard evidence
