Oscar Wilde was a <u>famous</u> Irish writer born on October 16, 1854, in Dublin, Ireland. His family was rich and he studied at Trinity College and later at Oxford <u>University</u>. Wilde is known for his humor, and his clever writing. His most famous works include *The Picture of Dorian Gray* and the play *The Importance of Being Earnest*. He also <u>wrote</u> many stories for children. He loved to challenge the rules of society and he often wrote about love and <u>beauty</u>. However, his life had many ups and downs. In 1895, he was sent to prison for two years because of his sexuality, which was a problem at that time. Wilde continued to write after he went out of <u>prison</u> but he had many health and money problems. He **died** on November 30, 1900, in Paris, France.
