Answers:

- 1 The tradition of pardoning a turkey by the President has its origins with President Abraham Lincoln who spared a live turkey gifted to him for Christmas. President Lincoln's son, Tad, adopted the turkey as a pet and successfully convinced his father not to turn it into a Christmas feast, leading to the first recorded presidential pardon of a turkey
- 2 Because it coincided with three major upcoming holidays falling on Thursdays, affecting sales in the poultry industry.
- 3 President Kennedy used the terms "pardon" and "reprieve" when declaring that he would let his gifted turkey live, setting a precedent for future administrations.
- 4 During the Nixon, Carter, and Reagan administrations, the tradition shifted towards sending the turkeys to farms rather than granting them clemency.
- 5 He did that in 1989, ensuring that the lucky bird would not end up on anyone's dinner table.
